Since the pandemic, Jeff has stewarded over **\$35 million** in community investments, launching initiatives such as **Action Labs** and **Future of Work** to drive systemic change. His leadership has transformed the organization's approach to grantmaking, evaluation, and strategy, earning high marks for community trust, collaboration, and measurable impact.

Jeff's connection to United Way began while leading **SEEDS**, a grassroots organization in Durham. That early partnership—rooted in trust-based philanthropy and equity—helped shape his belief in philanthropy as a tool for systemic change grounded in community.
